Virginia teaches Christian Education to years 7-10 at PGHS

- **Year 7**— (135 students out of 181 attend) This term, students have looked at particular teachings of Jesus and visiting a local church (Penshurst Uniting)
- **Year 8**— (140 out of 181 students attend) Following on from last term when we looked at how other religions differ from Christianity, this term we are looking at major aspects of Christianity and whether they personally accept these truths
- **Year 9**— (135 out of 165 students attend) This 3rd term, students have moved into the seminar format. They will be doing a 'Cafe Theme' (catering) and a 'Choices Theme'.
- **Year 10**— Students continue to look forward to each seminar. They regularly ask me when the next one is coming. So far, we've done a 'Princess Theme', a 'Warrior Theme', a 'Friend Theme', and a 'Café Theme'. In October, we will have a 'Party Theme'.

Virginia is also involved with Years 11 and 12 at the Oatley Campus. Her lunchtime group now aims to provide support to students through prayer and inviting guest speakers to share about opportunities for Christian connection outside of school.
