Prayer Points:

Below is a report on **Sending and Training Outreach Workers for the DuAn region**, from **Alfred and Alsie Ng**, our ministry partners in China. Please pray for them and for the work that God is expanding.

Vision: To reach out to more than 100 villages under the governance of the DuAn County (establishing a PP in each of the villages reached) and to help bring up & support a total of 50 preachers within the 5 years period July 2010-June 2015.

Progress of Outreach Work:

- 1) Prior to July 2010: A total of 9 villages were reached: LaTeng, NongWen, ShangChao, MinShe, JiuTian, YanYang, JiaHe, JiLong and AnFu.
- 2) Year #1 (July 2010-June 2011): 13 more villages were subsequently reached. MeiDong, DeYa, GuSan, LaLie, BaiWang, JiaGui, SuoTan, LaRen, JiuDu, CongYue, BanMai, LongZhong and XiaAo Villages.
- 3) Year #2 (July 2011-June 2012): 14 more new villages were added to the list:
 - i) XiaBa, AnLe (GanPeng) Villages & XiaAo Township by Lu FengQun & Liang YaoHui
 - ii) ShangZhen, CongSan, LongFu (DaCong), LuSan, NongMi & DiSu Village by Tang JinYing & WeiAiXiu
 - iii) JiaZuo Village by Lan YaoTian/Lan ZhenJiao
 - iv) TingLv (BaShi) Village by Lan LiangHuan/Lan ZhongXu
 - v) GuChao & BaiHuang (NongKun) Villages by LuLu, Wei HaiHui & Wei RuiGao
