MIC has been ministering in the Macarthur region for about 13 years. We are involved in men & women's ministry, youth & young adults, and we run a home work centre for Aboriginal kids. This is a much needed ministry because: NSW has the highest population of Aboriginal people within Australia (148,200); Sydney has the largest urban population of Aboriginal people (41,800); Macarthur Region has the 2nd highest population of Aboriginal people in NSW (approx. 10,000 people). **Pastor Michael Duckett** began pastoring Macarthur Indigenous Church in January 2008.

Prayer Points:

- Give thanks to God for our ministry team that, under God, ensures our effectiveness in ministering to our community of 10,000 Aboriginal people in the Macarthur Region.
