

Pray for Carolyn Moore in Malawi

Dear Friends,

In response to a request from Parish Council, I have been looking at projects in Malawi with which Penshurst Anglican Church may feel some connection. There are a lot of projects which need funding!

The two areas I would like to fund are Sunday School teacher training and Youth Ministries. My major reason for this is that **60% of the population in Malawi are under 25 years old** with many having lost parents from HIV/AIDs. I believe strong Christians are needed in Malawi to help bring about change as they walk with Jesus. My observation is there is a lack of Biblical knowledge. Education levels are low and children do not have a high status in Malawi.

Here are the two projects in greater detail:

SIM Project: M96556 Christian Education resources - funding for Sunday School Ministry Training. This connects with my friend Pastor Lovemore who a district coordinator and Jim Young /SIM who I have known since my time in 2012. The STUM (Sunday School Teachers United Movement) Director is pastor John Msowoya.

SIM Project: M96658 Youth Ministry Capacity Building - developing youth ministries in our partner church (African Evangelical Church, AEC), especially to provide training through camps, workshops, seminars etc. The SIM missionary involved with this work is Peter Ong from Sydney who came here with Jo, his wife and family in 2012.

The Africa Evangelical Church (AEC) in partnership with SIM desires to serve youth groups and youth leaders by providing effective training and mentoring. We are very committed to growing a youth ministry based on Jesus as the foundation of any good church ministry. Our vision is to see youth in Malawi come to know and worship Jesus Christ as Lord through His Gospel; and to become passionate growing disciples of Jesus, reaching out to the lost, bringing hope and transformation to a broken world.

P.S.—Mike Hammond, the Malawi SIM Director, says there are opportunities for short term teams to come to Malawi, if this is something the church would want to pursue. Always worthwhile considering! The other work which they are seeking people for is **Mandarin speakers** to reach the diaspora in Lilongwe. There are many Chinese in Lilongwe - mainly business people. Apparently, there is only one Christian amongst them! Wouldn't it be great if someone from our church felt they could serve God in that way?
