I received word from Carolyn Moore that Penshurst Anglican Church has kindly donated \$2500 towards the youth ministry that SIM is undertaking in Malawi. Thank you and the church for this generous gift!! This gift has come at a good time as we are getting ready for the 5 youth camps and 1 adolescent girls conference in August and December this year, and the donation will cover a considerable amount of the running cost for the camps. These camps are always a great opportunity for young people to hear the Gospel and to also grow in their faith. So thank you so much!!

I don't know whether you or anyone at church would be interested to receive our regular newsletters which gives updates on the ministries that my wife and I are serving in Malawi. If so, let me know and I can add you and others onto our email distribution list.

We will be on home assignment for 3 months in Sydney from mid-December onwards, and we'll be staying in Bexley which is not far from Penshurst. It'll be great to catch up with you some time over coffee.
