TIME...

Our thinking about time is from where we are towards what will come. It should be the other way around.

Our thinking should start from what will come and then towards where we are now.



Throughout the Bible we are told of the Day of the Lord (Isaiah 2:11, Jeremiah 30:7, Zechariah 14, Romans 2, 2 Thessalonians 2). It's the final day of history when God will end the world and establish his eternal kingdom. All people will be held to account (Revelation 20) and all things will be put right (Ephesians 1:10).

If that's what our future is then that should determine how we live now. Ephesians 5:12-21 tells us that we should wake up. We should live wise lives and make the most of this time for God's purposes. We don't give ourselves to pleasure filled living. We give ourselves to Spirit filled living which is reflected in thanksgiving and humility.
