God hears us in Prayer

The invitation to pray is for us to speak.

Prayer is not mystical experience which transcends words.

Prayer is about us **asking** (call [Gen 13:4], cry out [2 Chron 32:20] ask [Matt 21:22]) and God **hearing** (1 Kings 8:29, 9:3, Neh 1:6, Psalm 4:1, 17:1, 39:12, 54:2, 84:8). God gives attention to what we ask (1 Kings 8:28, 2 Chron 6:19-20) and answers (Gen 25:21, 2 Sam 24:25, Psalm 65:2).

Prayer is not a spiritual discipline. It's an expression of who we are. We are God's children reconciled to the Father through the redemptive work of Christ. By the Spirit we cry out, "Abba, Father"



Prayer is not mystical. It's not an activity that makes us a better person. Prayer expresses that we are children of God as we ASK of our heavenly Father. Please reflect on John 16:23-24:

Very truly I tell you, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.
